Creation of a Proof of Concept

A Proof of Concept project (PoC) is a good way to resourcefully and reliably check what kind of added-values serialization can offer. The goal of PoC is not only to provide you with a working demo app with company-specific use cases but also to examine the technical feasibility of product marking or labelling and develop a concept for the integration into your existing IT infrastructure. This makes a PoC the ideal perquisite to convince internal and external stakeholders; it allows you to better assess the benefits for the concrete application scenario and provides a concrete, tangible and reliable result.



What is a Proof of Concept?

A Proof of Concept is an important milestone during the development of a project. The goal is to examine whether an idea has the practical potential and how technical challenges can be mastered. The following questions are answered as part of a PoC: How do I mark my products? What has to be provided by the IT department? Which services are relevant and target-oriented?

Within the scope of a PoC with oneIDentity+, the creation of an abundance of slides in not a priority, but rather the practicability and demonstration of the possible application scenarios. In fact, the focus is on the development a demonstrator with the required core functionality. This demonstrator helps you to evaluate if the potential services can be a success. Furthermore, the openly accessible demo app offers the possibility to gather valuable feedback from users and decision makers. Consequently, a PoC acts as a basis of decision-making for the further course of the project. At the same time, it enables you to identify and minimise risks.



How does a Proof of Concept work?

Initially, challenges, goals, roles and the most important use cases are worked out in a joint workshop with the various stakeholders in your company.

Subsequently, we will carry out marking or labeling tests, together with our partners, in order to determine the most suitable method and technical feasibility for the serialized marking of your products and packaging.

At the same time, we will develop a basic IT concept together with your IT department on how to integrate serialization into your existing processes.

The development of a demonstrator app (iOS and Android) for the agreed use cases, which you can test yourself, is included as well.

Finally, we present the results and the demonstrator app to your stakeholders and management. Of course, you can continue to use the demonstrator app yourself to collect valuable feedback for your project from internal and external stakeholders.

Duration and costs

Every Proof of Concept project is unique. Depending on the effort, such a project costs about 15,000 € and typically only takes 3 months from idea to final presentation.

The creation of a Proof of Concept offers you many advantages. These include:

- Practical examination of feasibility and potential of a project idea
- Concrete, tangible result far beyond PowerPoint presentations like persuading your internal stakeholders
- Better estimation of costs, benefits and risks for the concrete application scenario
- Prototype (software) for acceptance testing and as basis for valuable feedback - internally as well as from external partners and suppliers
